‘Welcome Back’ for Tourism

Businesses across Wales are preparing to re-open, or to expand their current operations, as soon as government agrees. This focused course will equip you with a framework to plan and implement your re-opening safely and successfully, and to ensure your business is able to thrive in the new normal.

The programme is a package of essentials delivered live by expert tutors through an online learning platform. It has been developed to support the North Wales tourism, leisure and hospitality industry to get back into business.

The course is aimed at owners, managers and leaders with the responsibility for planning or implementing safe re-opening and expansion. Further options are available for operational and frontline teams.

The programme will cover three subject areas:

- **Strategy** Making the right business decisions for re-opening and into the future.
- **Safety** Interpreting safety guidance protocols for your business setting.
- **Service** Developing customer and community confidence in your business.

By the end of the course and following business-benefit-focused assessments, you will receive a certificate confirming your completion of the course as well as qualifying for a Highfield Level 2 Award in Risk Assessment. The strategic elements of the course are also eligible for certification as part of a Bangor University qualification².

The programme takes place over 9 half day sessions with the three themes interwoven to support your planning. The initial phase is focused over 7 working days with mentoring after the initial training to support you over and beyond the re-opening period.

Choose from one of four programmes (9 half day sessions), taking place:

A - 6th July - 14th July 2020

B - 20th July - 28th July 2020

Strategy

Led by Laurence Cox, Mike Scott or Eleri Llwyd Jones of the North Wales Business Academy (NWBA)

Title: Welcoming Back your Business after Covid 19

This course aims to provide knowledge, understanding and ability to review current business practice in the context of the impact and consequences of the Covid-19 pandemic. You will develop a business model, tactics and plans for future business operations. The course reflects upon the continual need for innovation and revising business operations.

Facilitated group discussion on the shared challenges but with a particular emphasis on re-opening for business. Collaborate & share best practice.

Duration: 4 x 2.5 hour sessions, with embedded assessed activities relevant to your business success. Plus individual mentoring sessions, post-opening, reflecting on your implementation.

Safety

Led by Huw Huws (Health & Safety)

Title: Interpreting Safety Guidance post Covid 19

Training on the essentials of carrying out and writing a risk assessment and method statements for you and your staff to implement safety guidance. Follow-on food-safety related module, where applicable, at extra cost. Includes the preparation of 'Toolbox Talks', to enable consistent briefing of staff to implement safe, risk-assessed working practices.

Duration: 2 x 3 hour sessions, followed by offline activity in risk assessment and method statement preparation. Follow-up group mentoring giving feedback on your documentation.

Service

Led by Tansy Rogerson – Tourism Business Development Consultant

Title: Get closer to your customer - from a distance

How to re-interpret your brand and service in the "new normal", starting with creating a caring culture, then embedding safety and sparkle, building confidence in your service, anticipating challenges and how to address them. This will enable you to re-engage with your customers and communities. Includes the preparation of 'Team talks' enabling whole-team buy in of your service strategy. Whole team module available, at extra cost.

Duration: 1 x 3 hour interactive session online, followed by offline activity in preparing your "Team talk" and follow-up group mentoring session.
